PET FOOD BANK VOLUNTEER

Value of this position: Our Pet Food Bank assists nearly 1000 animals annually who would otherwise go hungry. The Pet Food Bank enables families on any form of government assistance to keep their animals during times of temporary need. Do you have a passion for organization and want to roll up your sleeves and get a little dirty? Assist the Pet Food Bank in transporting donated pet food for the needy from our three PetCo drop off points: Kaneohe, Pearl City and Kapolei back to the Hawaiian Humane Society. Organize the food at the Humane Society for efficient distribution and keep updated logs of quantity of food and its usage. Ensure Pet Food Bank drop off points off-site and on-site are kept clean, orderly and stored properly if necessary.

Time commitment: 2 -3 days a week for a minimum of 6 months
